FEAC is a hands-on practitioner program designed for Business and IT professionals responsible for Enterprise Architecture (EA) projects within and for Federal agencies. Through a combination of classroom and mentored virtual classroom instruction for the performance of an actual project from your Agency or an Agency you contracted with, participants will develop the pragmatic skill sets necessary to initiate, develop, procure, and manage the implementation of an EA as required by recent Federal directives and regulations.

*In the past Sessions students have already been able to directly influence their EA needs in several Agencies, avoiding costly mistakes in outsourcing, assisted in making the right investment decisions regarding EA, elevated it to higher status within the Agencies and positively affect the internal EA efforts with funding the projects being developed during the program.*

The faculty and instructors of this **practitioner** program are recognized thought leaders and pioneers in the Federal arena, and are experienced in completing Federal EA projects. This unique curriculum involves only 2 non-contiguous weeks (over 2 months) out of the office, and the rest of the time you are at your job site solving your EA problems and creating actual EA pieces for your client while being monitored over Virtual Classroom using the Internet. In utilizing virtual classroom technology you receive continual feedback from FEAC faculty and peer review.

Passing the Certification Examination and Orals i.e. presenting their project before the FEAC faculty Board, students will earn the FEAC Examination Board Certification.

The FEAC program is supported and monitored by the Federal Architecture Working Group of the Federal CIO Council, the Zachman Institute, and California State University.

***The PRACTICUM part of the program includes modeling the processes, data, applications and IT infrastructure in a comprehensive way to build either a strategic EA or a security architecture or a data, application, IT platform architecture. This will include learning how to put in place the Governance and management support for making it a reality in the respective agencies or support contractors.***
